

Entry Criteria

1. Demonstrate excellence in leadership in infection prevention and control practice over a consistent period. Leaders may have implemented change within their group, their peers or organisation that has altered the way people think and perform. They may have overcome significant difficulty or adversity to achieve excellent outcomes within the profession or for their organisation. By setting an example through their leadership and drive the nominee may have worked toward improving patient care, health systems, governance or knowledge.
2. Demonstrate outstanding commitment to the leadership of the profession and discipline of infection prevention and control, and to the Australasian College for Infection Prevention and Control;
3. Demonstrated excellence in commitment to promoting infection prevention and control practice widely;
4. The nominee must at time of nomination be a current financial member of ACIPC;
5. The nominee (or delegate) must register and attend the ACIPC Annual Conference*

Award Rules

- The Claire Boardman CIP Medal for Leadership in Infection Prevention and Control shall be a biennial award offered in perpetuity from 2014
- A Selection Panel will be appointed by the ACIPC Board comprising the Chair as Censor-in-Chief, Ms Claire Boardman, and 2 external panel members one of whom is an experienced ICP
- The Award is bestowed upon an individual by the Board of the College on the recommendation of the Censor-in-Chief of the award, Ms Claire Boardman, via the Selection Panel
- The award will only be made where the Censor makes a recommendation to the Board where a suitable nomination is received and deemed appropriate. The Censor-in-Chief and Board of the College may elect to not bestow the award in any given year. The decision of the Censor-in-Chief and the Board of the College is final
- The Medal will be announced at the ACIPC Annual Conference 2022.

Application Process

- Individuals may self-nominate or be nominated by a third party. Please advise if the nominee is aware or not aware of their nomination at the time of submission.
- Entry forms & templates can be downloaded from the ACIPC website.
- Nominations must be submitted by emailing officemanager@acipc.org.au and address all entry criteria.
- Completed nominations must be received by the close of business September 2022 TBC. Nominations received after the closing date or those that do not address the entry criteria will be excluded from selection.
- All nominations are confidential, and the decision of the Selection Panel and Board is final.
