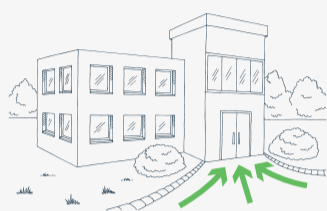

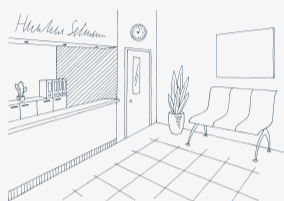
The 4 moments of hand hygiene when you visit a health facility

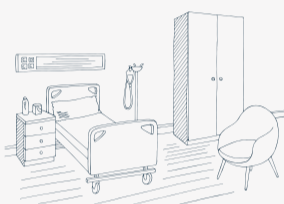
As you enter the building

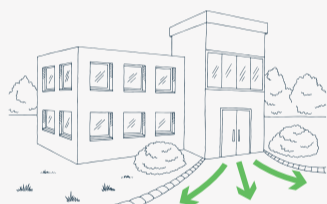
After touching shared items

Please use hand sanitiser every time you...

<p>1. Arrive</p>	<p>Why?</p>	<p>To stop germs on visitors' hands coming into the healthcare facility</p>
<p>2. Touch shared items: Lift buttons, chairs, hand railings, leaning on counters, bathrooms</p>	<p>Why?</p>	<p>To protect yourself from the germs of others who touched those surfaces and objects</p>
<p>3. Enter or exit a patient care area</p>	<p>Why?</p>	<p>To protect people – and spaces where they receive their treatment – from harmful germs</p>
<p>4. Leave</p>	<p>Why?</p>	<p>To protect yourself from germs you have had contact with in the healthcare facility</p>
