



CONSTRUCTION, RENOVATION & MAINTENANCE IN HEALTHCARE FACILITIES

Construction, renovation and maintenance activities are essential in healthcare settings but without careful planning, they can pose significant infection risks. This 12-week short course builds the knowledge and confidence to identify, assess and manage IPC risks throughout construction, renovation and maintenance projects, in collaboration with key stakeholders.

Delivered across two units, the course covers:

Unit 1 – IPC during construction, renovation and maintenance: identifying risk areas, planning and design, consultation and communication, risk assessment and management, specific settings, and unexpected events.

Unit 2 – Preventative maintenance for IPC: an introduction to preventative maintenance, water distribution systems, HVAC systems, and risks relating to other equipment.

Learning is supported by real-world case studies, scenario-based discussions and a live tutorial, helping participants apply theory to complex, practical problem-solving. Quizzes assess knowledge and skills throughout. This course is valuable for IPC professionals, project and facilities teams, engineering and maintenance staff, nurse managers, clinical leaders, and quality and safety staff.
