Survey 2: National HAI Prioritisation, Definitions and Minimum Dataset

Survey 2 asks participants to rate each candidate healthcare-associated infection (HAI) against the five priority criteria identified in Survey 1 to determine its overall priority for national surveillance. We then seek to identify the surveillance definition currently used in practice for each HAI, assessing the acceptability of this definition and recommend amendments to inform a national definition.

- HAI surveillance affects many clinical specialties
- Surveillance priorities influence quality improvement and patient safety
- Broad clinical input ensures approaches reflect contemporary practice
